Silver Embedded Plans: silver actuarial value medical plans that cover child dental services

High Actuarial Value (High AV) and Low Actuarial Value (Low AV): the percentage of total average costs for covered benefits that a plan will cover

SADPs: stand-alone dental plans


FDC: first dollar coverage, or a plan that covers 100% of the cost of preventive child dental services





STAND-ALONE DENTAL PLANS




AVERAGE MONTHLY PREMIUM FOR CHILD DENTAL COVERAGE



SILVER EMBEDDED PLANS ARE MORE LIKELY THAN SADPS TO PROVIDE first dollar coverage of child preventive dental services. In 2017, 65% of silver embedded plans provide EDC for child preventive services compared

silver embedded plans provide FDC for child preventive services compared to 51% of SADPs.
