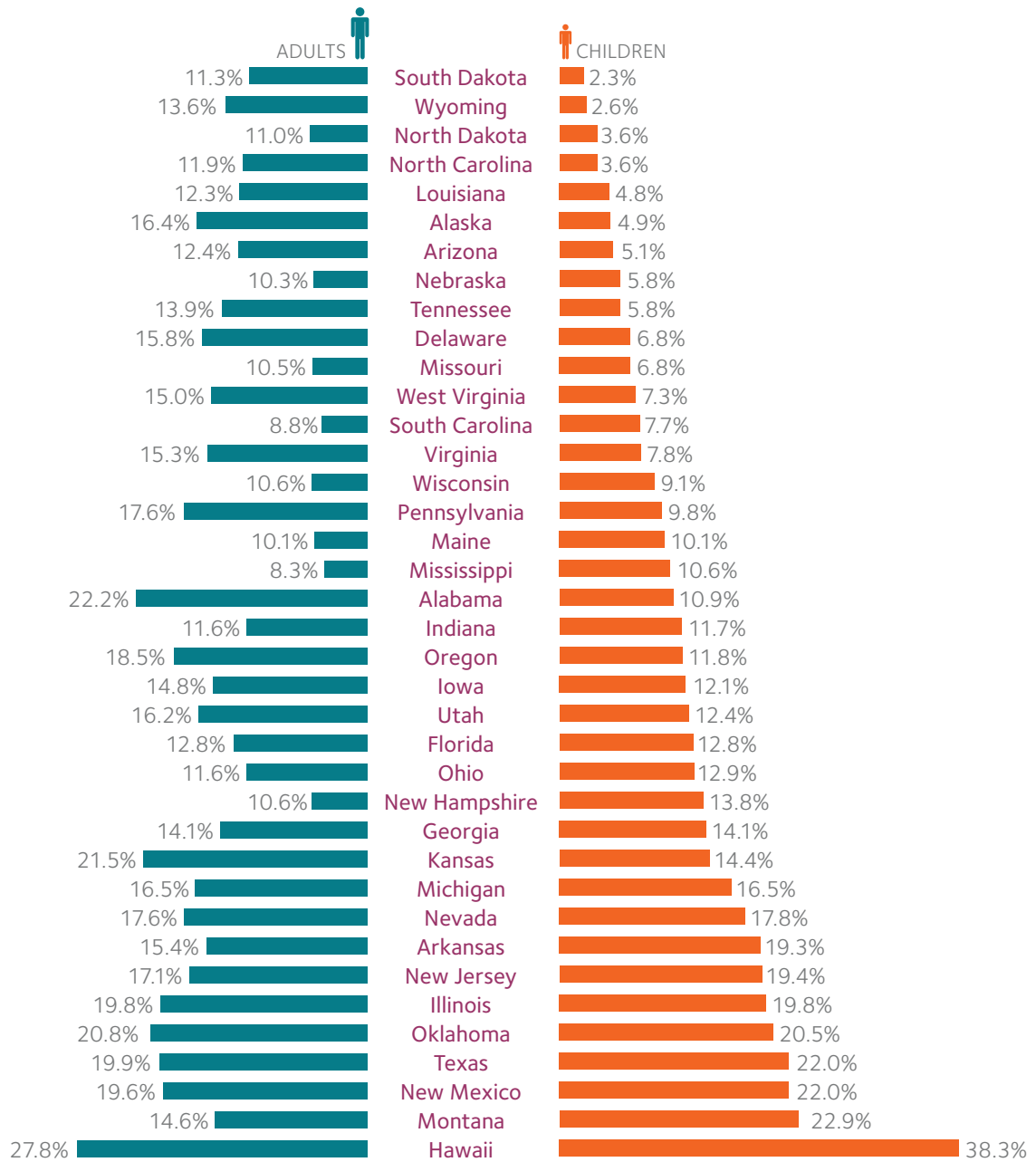
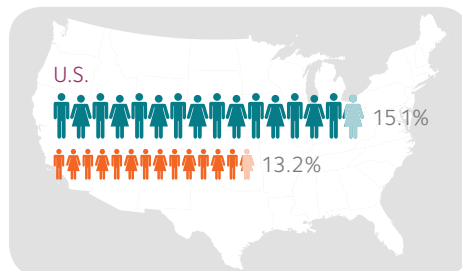


2016 Take-Up Rate of Stand-Alone Dental Plans in HealthCare.gov



Approximately **1,325,679** adults ages 18 and older selected a stand-alone dental plan through HealthCare.gov for the 2016 plan year.



Approximately **114,037** children under the age of 18 selected a stand-alone dental plan through HealthCare.gov for the 2016 plan year.

Notes: We separated individuals into two groups: children under age 18 and adults ages 18 and older. To calculate the take-up rate for stand-alone dental benefits, we divided the number of individuals in each age group that selected a stand-alone dental plan by the number of individuals in each age group that selected a medical plan in each state.
