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Charge 1. Status of Charge 1: In Progress

Develop a mechanism and format for continuing education credit to be made available for doctors and auxiliary personnel via the AAPD magazine, *PDT*. Act subsequently at the direction of the Board.

Background and Intent: Have one or two articles in each magazine that have questions to be answered on an answer sheet in paper or electronic format that could be submitted for CE credit. Each article would offer appropriate CE credit. Each article/credit hour would meet DANB/CERP standards. The fee for CE credit submission would be established by the AAPD Board of Trustees.

Progress Report for Charge 1

There were no direct questions pertaining to the introduction of journal articles in the *PDT* for CE credit purposes. However, from the membership survey, the *PDT* reflects a better usage by AAPD members compared to the journal-based continuing education program. This could mean a better utilization/response rate if the service is made available in the AAPD member magazine, *PDT*.
