



## FACT SHEET

Healthy Smiles, Healthy Children (HSHC) supports community-based initiatives nationwide providing Dental Homes to children from families who cannot afford dental care. Founded in 1987, Healthy Smiles, Healthy Children is the \$13 million philanthropic arm of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.

Since 2010, HSHC has released more than \$700,000 in support of Access to Care initiatives helping more than 100,000 children in 17 states. HSHC awards annually single-year grants of up to \$20,000 supporting dentist-led efforts in offering care to underserved children.

In 2014, the Foundation will:

- Release up to \$400,000 in single-year Access to Care Grants
- Introduce multi-year Access to Care Grants of up to \$375,000 each
- Hold its second annual HSHC *Dental Home Day*, providing Dental Homes for at least 100 children in Boston (2014 AAPD Annual Session host city)
